<a href="#">HB 90</a>	DPI/EC Division Feedback/DIT Study/PED Report	Horn, R-Union; Farmer-Butterfield, D-Wilson	Requires the Exceptional Children Division of DPI to develop a system of evaluation of the technical assistance/support programs provided to LEAs	
<a href="#">HB 107</a>	PED Oversight/EPP Changes	Horn, R-Union; Farmer-Butterfield, D-Wilson; Lucas, D-Cumberland	Makes changes to the Educator Preparation Program performance standards and data reporting system	
<a href="#">HB 144</a>	Hands Free NC	Corbin, R-Macon; Torbett, R-Gaston; Hardister, R-Guilford; Pierce, D-Scotland	Makes it unlawful to operate a vehicle (including school buses) on a public street, highway, or vehicular area while engaging in distracted behavior	
<a href="#">HB 151</a>	Katelyn's Law	Lambeth, R-Forsyth	Requires SBE to adopt rules excusing absences for student attending a legislative event or visiting the NCGA

<a href="#">HB 276</a>	Modify Low-Performing School Definition	Riddell, R-Alamance; Fraley, R-Iredell; Clemmons, D-Guilford; Ross, R-Alamance	Removes schools that "met expected growth" from low-performing school definition

<a href="#">HB 315</a>	Instructional Material Selection	Elmore, R-Wilkes; Arp, R-Union; Johnson, R-Cabarrus	Transfers the adoption of school textbooks and instructional supplies from the State to LEAs	LEAs don't have the same expertise/resources as the State; LEAs don't have the State's bulk purchasing power; LEAs are more likely to see increase in challenges to materials; if a challenge is upheld the material must be removed not replaced.

<a href="#">HB 521</a>	Transitional License/Teacher from Other State	Clemmons, D-Guilford; Horn, R-Union; Riddell, R-Alamance; Gailliard, D-Nash	Provides a 3-year transitional license for teachers from other states, authorizes LEAs to determine experience credit to pay them on the commensurate level, and modifies requirements for lifetime license

<a href="#">HB 714</a>	Competency-Based Assessments	Horn, R-Union; Blackwell, R-Burke	Directs SBE to recommend steps for a transition to a competency-based assessment/teaching model for all elementary and secondary students in NC	
<a href="#">HB 770</a>	Freedom to Work	Stevens, R-Surry; Bell, R-Wayne; Jones, R-Columbus; Zachary, R-Yadkin	Requires recognition by licensing boards of certain apprenticeship and training experiences -- licensure applicants are permitted to apply training hours earned through CTE in NC public schools and colleges towards requirements for licensure

<a href="#">HB 888</a>	Education Accommodations/Sickle Cell Disease	Floyd, D-Cumberland; Dobson, R-McDowell; Black, D-Durham	Directs State education agencies to adopt policies/guidelines to provide equal educational opportunity to student with sickle cell disease	
<a href="#">HB 895</a>	Opportunity Gap Task Force	Blackwell, R-Burke; Brockman, D-Guilford; Horn, R-Union; Meyer, D-Orange	Establishes the opportunity gap task force, which will receive input from public school teachers, principals, and superintendents
