NCDHHS Division of Child and Family Well-Being

The NC Department of Health and Human Services established a new division, the Division of Child and Family Well-Being (DCFW), in January 2022, to help the department actualize its vision that all children are healthy and thrive in safe, stable and nurturing families, schools, and communities. DCFW aligns complimentary behavioral health, physical health, and social programs to support whole person care and meet the escalating needs of children and families. Joining us is Yvonne Copeland, director of the division, to share about the work and services currently underway. Ms. Copeland will facilitate participant discussion about current best practices at the local level, as well as gaps that exist for needed services.

Evidence-Based Strategic Planning

The DPI Office of Learning Recovery is helping districts identify strategic priorities for recovery and acceleration (i.e., middle grades math, early literacy, middle and high school science, college enrollment) based on their data to use as part of local strategic plans and identify interventions to address those priorities.
